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RUSSELL The man in the orange hat points his finger in gloves down the track. I slide the chunky gear selector gently into the drive and grip wheel, ready to write a racing story. But the digital display flashes N, which means that the car is in a neutral position. Position. hit the shifter again, and again, this time a hard slap. N.N., N., N. I frantically wave Jim Leininger, chief of crew of Toyota Team Greensport. He clammers through the passenger door, barking at the crew. Click on the brake once! The brake pressed. The floor of the gas is three times! Once, twice, third time. Click on the brake again and try! Nothing but a N.A frown spreads across a weathered face under an orange hat as he scans a half-mile line looking for another car to wave forward. Leininger punches through a large dashboard button marked Power. The digital screen is empty damn computers, he mutters as the Toyota Prius buzzes and clicks and reboots itself.
